



Information on Admission to Kindergarten for 2025

Background of St. Stephen's Girls' College Kindergarten

1. As a Kindergarten embodied with the Christian spirit, we aim to provide quality early childhood education. We strive to provide our students with an engaging learning environment. A wide variety of activities that enhance students' moral, intellectual, physical, social and spiritual development will prepare them for lifelong learning. We are also committed to helping our students to develop their individual potential; to become individuals who know how to appreciate themselves, and respect others and care about the society.
2. Under the "Free Quality Kindergarten Education Scheme", our Kindergarten will handle admissions in accordance with the "Admission Arrangements for Nursery (K1) Classes in Kindergarten for the 2025/2026 School Year". 3. The maximum capacity of our Kindergarten is 180 students. In respect to the current school year, a total of 60 children will be admitted to the morning and afternoon classes for the Nursery Class (K1). A limited number of places may also be available for admission to Lower Kindergarten (K2) and Upper Kindergarten (K3).
4. School hours:
Morning class (K1): Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 12:00.
Morning class (K2): Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 12:10.
Afternoon class (K1): Monday to Friday from 13:00 to 16:00.
Afternoon class (K3): Monday to Friday from 13:00 to 16:10.
5. Our Kindergarten's medium of instruction is Cantonese.
6. Elementary English and Putonghua activities and games will be provided. The purpose is to provide students with the opportunity to familiarise themselves with additional languages at an early age.

3. **The relevant graduate certificate or diploma if you have declared the applicant's mother or sibling(s) is/are a graduate of our Primary/Secondary section**
4. **Application fee deposit slip (Please keep the original receipt or a printed copy of the electronic payment for submission on the Interview Day)**
5. **A passport size photo**

Nursery Class (K1): from 1st January 2022 to 31st December 2022
Lower Kindergarten (K2): from 1st January 2021 to 31st December 2021
Upper Kindergarten (K3): from 1st January 2020 to 31st December 2020

Date of Application

Application is accepted from 1st October 2024 to 15th October 2024 (both days inclusive).

Application Fee

The application fee is HK\$40 and is non-refundable. The application fee must be paid into the HSBC bank account as listed below:

Application Procedures

1. We only accept online applications.
2. Please fill out the online application form, upload a passport size photo, Certificate of Birth, the application fee deposit slip, and other relevant documents (if any) through the online application system. (Please be reminded that the name of the applicant should be written on the deposit slip.)
3. Fill out all required fields in the application form.
4. Application is not subject to any quota.
5. **Please ensure that the email address "no-reply@ssgc.eclass.hk" has been added to your safe list in order to prevent our confirmation email to be filtered as junk mail. Applicants who have submitted the online application form successfully will be shortlisted and notified by email for an interview before 28th October 2024. Interview Arrangement

The interview will be arranged for all candidates after submitting the online application successfully.

<p>Remarks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Due to a large number of applicants, another interview will not be arranged if the applicant is absent on the day of the interview (for any reasons, including illness or otherwise). All application fees paid are non-refundable. Please note the date and time of interview and bring along the requisite documents and a copy of the documents. Please show proof of the receipt of the application fee of \$40 upon interview. 		

Admission Criteria

- Home-to-school distance taken into account when given admission to students.
- Higher priority is given to applicants whose sisters have studied in our Primary School.
- In order to maximise our students' opportunities to be admitted to our Primary School, we will also admit students with reference to Education Bureau's Primary One Admission System (POAS). The POAS is as follows:
 - Parent(s) teaching or working full time in the kindergarten or secondary section if it is of the same address as the primary school (20 points)
 - Sibling(s) studying in the secondary section if it is of the same address as the primary school (20 points)
 - Parent(s) being a school manager of the primary school (20 points)
 - Parent(s) or sibling(s) being a graduate of the primary school (10 points)
 - First-born child (the eldest child in the family irrespective of gender) (5 points)

[Applicant children may claim only one of the relationships from (i) to (v).]

 - Same religious affiliation as the sponsoring body which operates the primary school (5 points)
 - Parent(s) being a member of the same organisation which sponsors the operation of the primary school (5 points)

[Applicant children may claim only one of the relationships from (vi) to (vii).]
- In principle, applicants will have a higher chance of admission if he/she has higher points under the POAS. However, admission is also subject to the performance of the applicant during the interview. Our Kindergarten reserves the right to admit applicants with lower points or no points under the POAS.
- According to the POAS adopted by the Education Bureau, our school cannot guarantee admission of all our students to our Primary School.

Registration Guide:

1. Successful applicants are required to visit our Kindergarten to complete the centralised registration during the “centralised registration dates” from 2nd January 2025 to 4th January 2025.
2. Successful applicants are required to submit the “Registration Certificate for Kindergarten Admission” , a copy of your child’s birth certificate or copies of documents indicating the child is permitted to reside in Hong Kong and HK\$970 as the registration fee. Late submission will result in the placement allocated being forfeited. The waiting list will be kept until 31st September 2025.
3. If an applicant wishes to change schools after registration, he/she is required to notify the Kindergarten in writing to retrieve the “RC” / “AP”. Upon retrieving the “RC” / “AP” from the Kindergarten concerned, the Kindergarten will no longer reserve the placement for the applicant. Hence, the registration fee paid to the Kindergarten will not be refunded.
